Your Privacy

At Techs On Call, we recognize that when you choose to provide us with information about yourself through our web site, you trust us to act in a responsible manner. What Information does Techs On Call Collect? How do we Use It?

At times we may request that you voluntarily supply us with personal information on our web site. Generally, this information is requested when you register for a newsletter, email alert or other service or when you request that we contact you to provide further information about our services. Techs On Call collects this information to record and support your participation in the activities you select. We may also use this information to keep you informed about new services and special offers from Techs On Call and our selected service partners, but you will always have the choice not to receive such information.

Will Techs On Call Disclose the Information it Collects to Outside Parties?

Techs On Call may store and disclose personal information as allowed or required by applicable law, including making disclosures that are necessary or advisable to: (a) protect the rights, safety or property of users of our web site, the public, or Techs On Call or our web site suppliers; and (b) conform to legal or regulatory requirements.

Techs On Call may provide aggregate statistics about our customers, sales, traffic patterns, and related site information to reputable third-party vendors, but these statistics will not include any personally identifying information. Also, in connection with certain Techs On Call services and activities (for example, customer satisfaction surveys), the collection, transferring, storage and processing of your information may be undertaken by trusted vendors of Techs On Call. Such vendors are bound by contract to not use your personal information for their own purposes or provide it to any third parties.

How does Techs On Call Protect Personal Information?

We take reasonable steps to protect the data we collect from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. We do this by implementing industry standard security procedures for storing and accessing information. However, you should be aware that we cannot ensure that all of your private communications and other personally identifiable information will never be disclosed in ways not otherwise described in this Privacy Policy. By way of example (without limiting the foregoing), we may be forced to disclose information to the government or third parties under certain circumstances, third parties may unlawfully intercept or access transmissions or private communications, or users may abuse or misuse your information that they collect from our site.

What about "cookies"?

"Cookies" are small pieces of information that are transferred to your browser and stored on your computer's hard drive. Our cookies enable us to provide you with more personal service. Cookies also allow us to track usage patterns, trends and other aggregate visitor information. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually change your browser to prevent that if you would rather not store the information for future use. We may also collect certain technical and routing information about your computer to facilitate your use of the site and its services (such as browser type, operating system and the Internet Protocol ("IP") address of your computer). Without expressly informing you in each particular instance, we do not match such information with any of your personal information.

We may offer links to third party sites from our site. Please note that we are not responsible for the content or privacy practices of any non-Techs On Call sites to which we may link. You should review the privacy policy of such sites before using the sites or providing any personal information.

A Note to Children and Parents
